SPECIAL AWARD CLASSES

Judged by Ms. Mikaela Short

There will be special award classes judged during the lunch break the classes are held to enable a judge from the B & C judges lists to gain experience.

They are not part of the championship show and losing dogs can compete in the championship show as unbeaten dogs.

The classes are free to enter but dog(s) must be entered in the championship show with the exception of those entering the Special Award Champions class.

The classes which are not numbered are :-

Special Award Yearling Dog or Bitch (SAY)
Special Award Mid Limit Dog or Bitch (SAML)
Special Award Champions Class (SACC)

All entries must be made on the show entry form using the class initials.

DEFINITION OF CLASSES

In the following definitions a Challenge Certificate includes any show award that counts towards the title of Champion under the Rule of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club Ltd..

Wins at championship shows in breed classes where Challenge Certificates are not on offer shall be counted as Open shows. In the case of a dog owned in partnership and entered in Members classes or competing for Members Specials, each partner must be a Member of the Society at the time of entry.

In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including the seventh day before the closing date for entries shall be counted when entering for any class i.e., 27th February 2017.

Wins in variety classes do not count for entry in breed classes, but when entering for variety classes, wins in both Breed and Variety classes must be counted. A first prize does not include a Special Prize of whatever value.

If an exhibitor reports before the judging of a class that a dog has been entered which is ineligible, the exhibitor may choose from one of the following options:

- (1) WITHDRAWAL: The dog may be withdrawn from competition subject to the conditions of Regulations 9 (j) and 20.
- (2) TRANSFER:
 - (a) If a dog is ineligible for a class or classes as regards its breed, colour, sex, weight or height, the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the equivalent class or classes for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height and, in the event of there being no equivalent class, Minor Puppy and Puppy excepted, to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
 - (b) For an exhibit entered incorrectly in a Minor Puppy class, Puppy Class Junior class or Yearling class which is over age but under twelve calendar months of age, eighteen calendar months of age, or 24 calendar months of age respectively the show secretary shall transfer the exhibit to the Puppy Class, Junior Class or Yearling class respectively for the correct colour, sex, weight or height and in the event of there being no Puppy, Junior Class, or Yearling class, to the Open Class for the correct sex, colour, weight or height.
 - (c) For any reason other than the above, the Show Secretary shall transfer to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
 - (d) If an exhibit arrives late or misses a class, even if it is the only class in which the dog is entered, the dog may not be transferred to any other class.

Definitions of classes:-

Minor Puppy (MP) – For dogs of six, and not exceeding nine, calendar months on the first day of the show.

Puppy (P) – For dogs of six, and not exceeding twelve, calendar months of age on the first day of the show.

Junior (J) – For dogs of six, and not exceeding eighteen, calendar months of age on the first day of the show.

Yearling (Y) - For dogs of twelve and not exceeding twenty four calendar months of age on the day of the show

Novice (N) - For dogs that have not won a Challenge Certificate or three or more first Prizes at Open and Championship Shows (Minor Puppy, Special Minor Puppy, Puppy and Special Puppy classes excepted whether restricted or not.

Undergraduate (UG) – For all dogs that have not won a Challenge Certificate or 3 or more 1st prizes at Championship shows where challenge certificates were offered for the breed (Minor Puppy, Special Minor Puppy, Puppy and Special Puppy classes excepted whether restricted or not.

Post Graduate (PG) - For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or five or more 1st prizes at Championship shows in Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open classes, whether restricted or not where challenge certificates were offered for the breed.

Mid Limit (ML) For dogs which have not become show champions under Kennel Club Ltd. regulations or under the rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club Ltd. or won 5 or more first prizes in all at Championship shows in Mid Limit, Limit & Open classes confined to the breed, whether restricted or not, at shows where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

Limit (L) - For dogs which have not become show champions under Kennel Club Ltd. regulations or under the rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club Ltd. or won seven or more 1st prizes at Championship shows in Limit and Open classes where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

Open (O) – For all dogs of the breed for which the class is provided and eligible for entry at the show.

Veteran (V) – For dogs of not less than seven years of age on the first day of the show.

Not For Competition (NFC) Societies may at their discretion accept not for competition entries. Societies may accept such entries from breeds of dog not included within the title of the society.

SPECIAL AWARD CLASSES

Special Award Yearling Dog or Bitch (SAY) - For Dogs of six and not exceeding twentyfour calendar months of age on the first day of the show, and that are entered in the championship show.

Special Award Mid Limit Dog or Bitch (SAML) - For dogs which have not become show champions under Kennel Club Ltd. regulations or under the rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club Ltd. and that are entered in the championship show.

Special Award Champions Class (SACC) - For dogs which have become show champions under Kennel Club Ltd. regulations or under the rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club Ltd. Dogs entered in this class do not need to be entered in the Championship show.

REGULATIONS FOR THE PREPARATION OF DOGS FOR EXHIBITION F (ANNEX B)

- (1) These Regulations must be observed when a dog is prepared for exhibition and/or exhibited at any Kennel Club Ltd. Licensed event. Objections may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under these show Regulations and/or for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Ltd. Rule A.42.
- (1a) A dog found to have been exhibited in breach of these regulations will automatically be disqualified from exhibition at the show and from any award gained there.
- (1b) Unless the exhibitor provides a satisfactory explanation for the dog being in breach of these regulations, he/she may be subject to further penalties of either a fine or as listed under rule A42.
- (2a) No substance which alters the natural colour, texture, or body of the coat may be present in the dog's coat for any purpose at any time during the show. No substance which alters the natural colour of any external part of the dog may be present on the dog for any purpose at any time during the show.
- (b) Any other substance (other than water) which may be used in the preparation of a dog for exhibition must not be allowed to remain in the coat or on any other part of the dog at the time of exhibition.
- (3) No act or operation which alters the natural conformation of a dog or any part thereof may be performed except:-
 - a. Operations certified to the satisfaction of the General Committee.
 - b. The removal of dew claws of any breed.
 - c. Operations to prevent breeding, provided that such operations are notified to the Kennel Club Ltd. before neutered dogs are shown.Nor must anything be done calculated to in the opinion of the General Committee to deceive.
- (4) The General Committee, without previous notice, may order an examination of any dogs at the show. Any examination thus ordered will be made by a person having executive authority who shall have a written directive from the Kennel Club Ltd. in their possession. Samples may be taken for further examination and analysis.
- (5) An individual has the right to lodge an objection to a dog if he/she is the owner or handler of a dog competing in the same breed or class. An objection may however be lodged by an official of the show or by anyone so deputed by the Kennel Club Ltd.. It will be the responsibility of the individual who lodged the objection or the official (as appropriate), to substantiate the grounds for the objection. The Kennel Club Ltd. will substantiate the grounds for an objection made on its behalf.
- (6) Any objection by an individual related to an infringement of these regulations must be made in writing to the Show Secretary at his/her office before the close of the Show and the individual must produce evidence of identity at the time of lodging the complaint.

SHOW REGULATIONS

- (1) The show will open at 9.00 am.
- (2) Dogs will be received at any time, but it is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure that exhibits are available for judging when required.
- (3) Judging will commence at 10.00 am.
- (4) Exhibits may be removed from the Show after their judging has been completed. The Show will close half an hour after all judging has been completed.
- (5) The use of cooking stoves in the proximity of the tenting and benching areas is for bidden except as authorised by the show management.
- (6) The entry for members is £11.00 per dog 1st entry, and for non-members £15.00 per dog 1st entry. Subsequent entries with the same dog are £2.00. NFC £3.00 per dog.

- (7) Prize money – First £2.00 : Second £1.00 : Third 50p.
- (8) The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
- (9) Puppies under six calendar months of age on the first day of the show are not eligible for exhibition.
- (10) The mating of bitches within the precincts of the Show is forbidden.
- (11) **BEST PUPPY IN SHOW:** Where a Best Puppy in Show competition is scheduled the Best Puppy in Show is a puppy which has competed and is unbeaten by any other puppy exhibited at the same Show. A puppy is a dog of six and not exceeding 12 calendar months of age on the first day of the show. Where the Best in Show is a puppy it will also automatically be Best Puppy in Show respectively. Similarly, if the Reserve Best in Show is a puppy which has only been beaten by an adult dog, it will also automatically be Best Puppy in Show respectively. Consequently, selection of Best Puppy in Show must follow the selection of Best in Show respectively.
Best Puppy in Show must be selected from puppies which have been judged and which are unbeaten by any other puppy.
- WITHDRAWAL FROM COMPETITION:** Puppies which become eligible for Best Puppy in Show may be withdrawn from all other competition other than Breed classes prior to the competition for Best Puppy in Show as appropriate in order to remain unbeaten. A puppy beaten in competition for Best Puppy in Show may subsequently be exhibited in all competition for which it was previously eligible. The dog declared Best Puppy in Show however, must not compete in any subsequent competition. Proviso:- Dogs beaten in competition for Stud dog, Brood bitch, Progeny, Brace and Team or a special award confined to one breed will not be considered to be a beaten dog.
- (12) **BEST IN SHOW** The dog declared Best in Show is a dog which has competed and is unbeaten by any other dog exhibited at the same show. Best in Show must be selected from the exhibits declared Best of Sex provided they are unbeaten winning dogs. Reserve Best in Show must be selected from the Best Opposite Sex and the Reserve Best of Sex to the exhibit declared Best in Show. The dogs declared Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show must not compete in any subsequent competition.
WITHDRAWAL FROM COMPETITION: Dogs that become eligible for Best in Show may be withdrawn from all other competition other than breed classes prior to the competition for Best in Show as appropriate in order to remain unbeaten. A dog beaten in competition for Best in Show may subsequently be exhibited in all competition for which it was previously eligible. The dogs declared Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show, however must not compete in any subsequent competition. Proviso:- Dogs beaten in competition for Stud dog, Brood bitch, Progeny, Brace and Team or a special award confined to one breed will not be considered to be a beaten dog.
- (13) Exhibits will not be admitted to the Best in Show competition after a period of ten minutes has elapsed since the announcement that exhibits are required for judging, unless they have been unavoidably delayed by previous judging not being completed on time, and then only with the special permission of the Show Management.
- (14) No modifications will be made to this schedule except by permission of the General Committee of the Kennel Club Ltd., which will be followed by advertisements in the Canine Press wherever possible.
- (15) All exhibitors must be familiar with Kennel Club Ltd. Regulation F (Annex B) Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition.
- (16) All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Ltd. Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
- (17) **DOGS IN VEHICLES ON HOT DAYS.**
Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather and the Kennel Club Ltd. offers the following guidance to help guide you through the do's and don'ts travelling to and whilst at KC licensed events.
When travelling to a show please take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a bus holiday route, and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams.
If your vehicle is not air-conditioned seriously consider whether travelling to the show is a good idea at all. The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible, and plenty of stops should be taken, with lots of water available to drink.
Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog.
When at the show, never leave your dog in the vehicle.
Keep the dog in the shade - take your own shade, for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of water available to drink so your dog stays well hydrated.
Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion, or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths of time.

Remember, if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated, and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare.

WARNING: IF YOUR DOG IS FOUND TO BE AT RISK FORCIBLE ENTRY TO YOUR VEHICLE MAY BE NECESSARY WITHOUT LIABILITY FOR ANY DAMAGE CAUSED.
